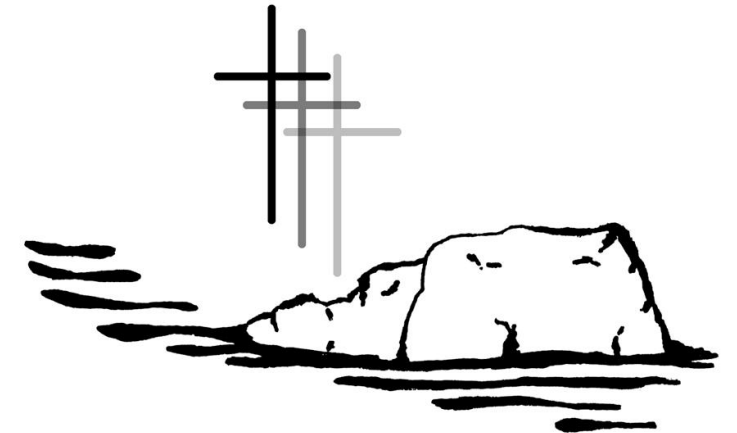
PRAYER POINTS
